

Additional R.I.D.E.R.'s Mini Camp Information

PINEBROOK FARMS' R.I.D.E.R.'s Weekends, are overnight mini-camps. Their purpose is to provide youngsters with an opportunity to improve their horsemanship skills while having a great time in a safe, family orientated, environment. The Clinic will offer six hours of riding lessons, horsemanship instruction, cook out, a non denominational devotional. Other activities may include; vaulting, games, contests, and prizes, archery, arts and crafts.

Great meals and snack bar are also provided.

Riding in the Spring & Fall can be fun and challenging. While the bunkhouses and dining hall are air conditioned & heated, and we do have an 80' x 200' covered arena, please prepare students to be warm and dry while riding and enjoying outdoor activities.

ALL PARTICIPANTS/STUDENTS MUST BRING:

- ☆ Sleeping bag & pillow/pillow case
- ☆ Set of twin bed sheets
- ☆ One (1) large towel and wash cloth
- ☆ One (1) flashlight w/batteries
- ☆ Personal toiletry articles including: sun screen, and insect replant.
- ☆ "Every-Day" Clothes for two (2) days
 - Jean type pants or britches to ride in, T shirt (no spaghetti straps, halters, or midriff shirts.
 - Smooth sole riding boots: No one will be allowed to ride in hiking boots or tennis shoes.
 - Casual clothes and tennis shoes for afternoon activities, jackets, gloves and raincoats appropriate for weather conditions.
 - Cap or hat
- ☆ Dirty clothes bag.
- ☆ No footlockers or trunks - suitcases only (must fit under bunk 10")
- ☆ **Riding helmets are required** (If you do not own one, we will provide one for you.)

PLEASE MARK ALL CLOTHING AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS WITH STUDENT'S NAME.

Grooming equipment provided:

(You may bring your own if you prefer)

- ☆ Curry brush
- ☆ Body brush
- ☆ Finish brush
- ☆ Mane comb
- ☆ Hoof pick
- ☆ Sweat scraper
- ☆ Saddle: including girth/cinch and/or fittings
- ☆ Bridle and reins including a safe bit, curb chain, if needed
- ☆ Two (2) saddle pads
- ☆ Good stout halter and lead rope with strong snap
- ☆ Any other equipment or tack your individual horse may need

STUDENTS WITH THEIR OWN HORSE:

A HEALTH CERTIFICATE, CURRENT (LESS THAN 12 MONTHS OLD) COGGINS TEST IS REQUIRED, AND A HORSE OWNER'S RELEASE FORM IS REQUIRED.

If your horse is on any medication or has any special problems, please inform the staff in advance.

****Horses required to have a health certificate from a Veterinarian within the last ten (10) days & be current on all inoculations including the Rhino Flu.****

- ☆ We provide a good, well balanced horse feed, & clean, nutritious hay.
- ☆ Students may bring their own feed and hay but there is no reduction in mini camp fee.
- ☆ Horses are kept in clean, safe stalls & pens, or in pasture if requested.
- ☆ Please check all tack carefully to make sure it fits the horse and child (child's feet must reach the stirrups). Make sure all rigging is strong, secure, and safe.
- ☆ All tack is stored separately on racks. Caring for and cleaning this equipment is an important part of the student's daily routine.
- ☆ Owners are asked to sign a release form, holding camp free from liability if horse injures any person, horse, or damages property.

STUDENTS MUST NOT BRING:

Foot lockers, snack food, gum, electronic games, cell phones, suggestive music, nor clothing exhibiting student's midsection or with suggestive graphics.
